DATE OF GRADE CHECK	DATE ELIGIBILITY IS LOST / GAINED	STUDENT ELIGIBILITY STATUS
September 30	October 7, 2011	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
October 21	October 28, 2011	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
November 10	November 17, 2011	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
December 2	December 9, 2011	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
December 20	January 12, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period become ineligible. (See Holiday Rule)
January 25	February 1, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
February 16	February 23, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
March 9	March 26, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period remain eligible. (See Holiday Rule)
April 13	April 20, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.

May 4	May 11, 2012	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period remain eligible.

	GRACE PERIOD	All Grading and Evaluation periods are followed by a 7 day grace period which ends at the end of the school day.
	HOLIDAY RULE	All Students are eligible during a school holiday of a full calendar week or more.
