



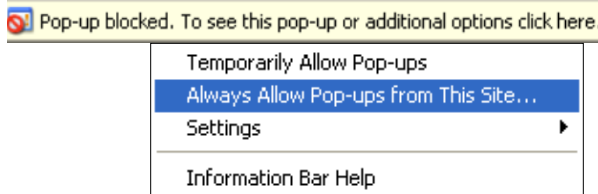
Creating Your ParentConnection Account

Note: Please do not attempt to create an account until you have received an official letter from AISD containing your student's PIN number.

- Open your Internet browser. In the address field type <https://gradespeed.austinisd.org/pc>

- Click the link in the lower left corner to sign up. "Click here to signup"

- When prompted, turn off any Pop-Up blockers. **Note:** This example is for Internet Explorer. Other browsers will turn pop-ups off differently.



- Create your Username.
- Enter a password of your choice and confirm.

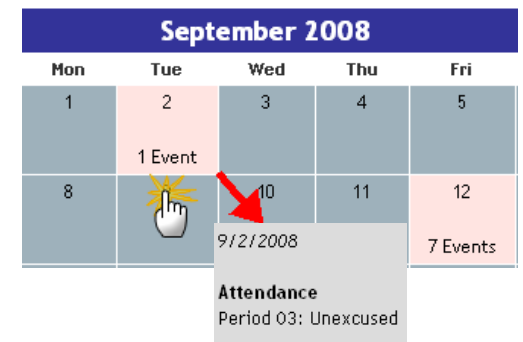
