<b>Guidance &amp; Counseling</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Implement comprehensive guidance and counseling program</li> <li>• Focus on academic achievement, prevention, and intervention services</li> <li>• Social/emotional development of all students</li> <li>• Career development services</li> </ul>
<b>Peer Assistance and Leadership (PAL)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cross-age mentoring program at elementary, middle, and high schools</li> <li>• Older students mentor younger students one-on-one</li> <li>• Trained in peer mediation</li> <li>• PALS complete community service hours</li> </ul>
<b>AVID</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Primarily first-generation college students from groups usually under-represented in universities</li> <li>• Students in the academic middle</li> <li>• Elective class focuses on: curriculum, tutorial, and motivation</li> </ul>
<b>Discipline</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure Texas law is enforced fairly with all students</li> <li>• Maintain a safe environment for students at school and school functions</li> <li>• Coordinate with law enforcement when necessary</li> </ul>
<b>Child Study Teams</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intensive problem solving for students with more significant academic, behavioral, and/or attendance challenges</li> <li>• Follow Response to Intervention (RtI) framework</li> <li>• Consists of a Child Study Facilitator, Social Service Specialist, and Drop-out Prevention Specialist</li> </ul>

Child Study Facilitator:

- Responsible for overseeing effective delivery of services through Child Study Team
- Ensure staff members understand how to use eCST
- Provide training to campus staff

Social Service Specialist:

- Licensed counselors or social workers
- Primary responsibility is to link students and families with intensive need to school and community resources
- Provide support for critical incidents and crisis intervention

Drop-out Prevention Specialist:

- Work with administrators, teachers, and social workers
- Provide interventions that encourage improvement in achievement, attendance, and social/emotional development and behavior
